Maksym Artemenko Pianist

At 16, he was accepted into the Kharkiv National Kotlyarevsky University of Arts, where he studied under Professor Olga Fekete. In 2023, he completed his bachelor's degree in piano.

Over the years, Maksym has participated in various international competitions and has received recognition at events such as the Sheepdrove Piano Competition, Kharkiv Assemblies, Czerny Competition, Amadeus International Competition (Kharkiv, Ukraine), Chords of Khortytsia (Zaporizhzhia, Ukraine), and the Chopin Competition (Narva, Estonia).

He has also taken part in festivals such as the Kharkiv Assemblies and the Chamber Music Academy YSOU in Germany. Additionally, he has gained valuable insights through masterclasses with renowned piano professors and pianists, including Ji Liu, Dr. Min Kwon, Martino Tirimo, William Fong, Andriy Baryshevsky and Tatiana Verkina.

Since July 2022, Maksym has continued his studies with Professor Mikhail Kazakevich at Trinity Laban.
